How to go from Bishop Lei to HKU East gate

A) Use a taxi

• Bishop Lei free taxi

Bishop Lei might provide some free taxi/shuttle to go to the Hong-Kong University but their number is limited. Therefore you have to interact in advance with the front Desk to be sure of the aviability of such transportation.

Hong Kong taxi

In Hong-Kong, taxis are rather cheap (compare to others cities) and really convenient to travel around the city. To get a taxi no need to make reservation: just stand in the street and wave your hand when you see a taxi passing by.

- From Bishop Lei to HKU ask to go to HKU EAST GATE.
- From HKU to Bishop Lei ask to go to Bishop Lei

Price for the transportation should be around 20-30 HKD. You cannot use octopus card and you will most likely not been able to use credit card so you need to prepare some bills/coins to pay by cash.

During the rush hours (8-9 AM and 6-7PM) it might be a bit more difficult to find a taxi than during the rest of the day.

Travel time is about 10-15 minutes.

B) Use a public bus


Different buses can bring you to the HKU east gate. The bus service from Hong-Kong is really good and frequent. There is no time table for the bus but in principle one will not wait more than 10 minutes at any bus stop to get a ride. Travel time is around 10-15 minutes.

Several bus line can transport you between the two locations. The most convenient are the following ones: 23, 40, 40M and 103. Be careful not to take 23B which will not go up to HKU East gate.

One way cost roughly 5-6 HKD. You can pay with octopus card (recommended) or cash if you don't have one. Note that if you pay by cash you need the exact amount of money since the bus driver will not make any adjustments.


• From Bishop Lei to HKU

From Bishop Lei you will need to walk a bit to reach the bus stop. Below is presented two alternative way to go there. Both of them will make you walk along the Hong-Kong biological garden:



Taking one of these paths will make go down with a rather steep slope so be careful not to slip in case of rain.

You will find the bus stop easily in the street:




From the bus take any of the 23, 40, 40M, 103 line and stop at the **Hong-Kong University East gate**. The bus stop is close to the entrance of the University.



• From HKU to Bishop Lei

You need to walk a bit from the eat gate to reach the bus.



Once arrived to the bus stop wait and take buses from line 23 or 40. Drop at the Raimondi college stop (just in front Bishop Lei).


Buses from Line 40M or 103 can also be taken but we will drop you at Caritas Center bus stop which is close to the bus stop you take to come to HKU (so you will need to climb back to Bishop Lei).



3) Walk to HKU (for courageous people)

If you like to like to walk or if you want discover Central district between Bishop Lei and HKU you can go to the East Gate by walk. The walk take 20-25 minutes if you are used to it and more than 30 minutes the first time. Be aware of the weather forecast before going out and take an umbrella in any case (you can check http://www.hko.gov.hk/contente.htm for the weather).
